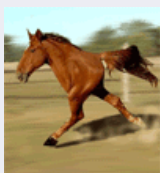

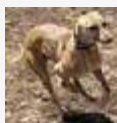

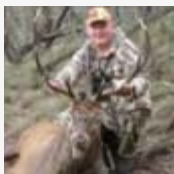

Police are investigating the death of a man who was shot dead in a hunting accident in Victoria's north-east.

A 19-year-old man from Thurgoona in New South Wales was accidentally shot dead in a remote area near Tallangatta on Sunday afternoon.

The man was hunting with two other men in dense scrub, when he became separated from them about 5:00pm (AEST).

Police believe one of the men mistook him for a deer and fired a shot at him.

One of the men then went to a nearby farm house to get help.

Police and paramedics walked for about 40 minutes through thick bush to reach the man but he was dead when they arrived.

A report is being prepared for the coroner.
